

Christian Education In Schools for Middle & Senior Students

Christian Education is available as a curriculum option at Kingsford Smith School because parents have requested it, based on provisions in the Education Act 2004. The service provider for Christian Education is CEIS, who has now partnered with Young Life Australia (www.younglife.org.au) and St James Anglican Church to include a session designed specifically for middle/senior students. This is an educational option offered in a relaxed and fun way, to improve personal resilience, social understanding and community connections.

The middle/senior Christian Education session will be one-hour per term, that builds supportive relationships while exploring life values, questions and Christianity. The broad term topics will be:

Term 1: Easter – what does it mean?

Term 2: Beyond You – God and human beliefs

Term 3: Bible Bonanza – is this big story a big deal? Thursday 13 September from 2.00-3.00pm

Term 4: Christmas Celebrations – Jesus joins human reality Thursday 6 December from 2.00-3.00pm

Parent permission is essential and remains in effect while your child remains at the school (requests can also be made or changed at any time, via the front office).
