Koori Pre-School Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What is Koori Pre-School? The Koori Pre-school program at KSS is in partnership with the Wirrapanda Foundation. The Koori Pre-school provides early childhood education to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children aged 3-5 years. Children under the age of three are welcome to attend when accompanied by a parent or adult carer.
- 2. How often does it run? Our program runs two half days a week. 4 year old children who attend the Koori preschool program at the beginning of the week are able to attend the 4 year old preschool program for the rest of the week.
- 3. What educational opportunities are provided? The Koori preschool program provides opportunities for children to engage in rich play based experiences fostering a love of learning, student well-being, transitions to school and the development of early literacy and numeracy skills. Within each program there is a strong focus on culture and identity. Collaborative partnerships between families and educators are fostered to guide children's understandings in a culturally safe and inclusive learning environment.
